

Using the LCD Memo Board

• Detach the stylus from the top, and write or draw on the LCD screen.

(For best writing experience, please only use the included stylus with this memo board.)

- Switch the erase/lock switch to to enable the erase function.

 Switch the erase/lock switch to to disable the erase function.
- When the erase function is enabled, press the erase button on the front to erase entire screen.

- Use the magnet on the back to attach to fridge or any other flat steel surface.
- Insert stylus through the stand & hanging hole to use as a stand.
- Hang tablet by using the stand & hanging hole directly, or inserting a string (not included) through the hole and securing.

Changing the Battery

- The memo board is powered by 1 x CR2016 button cell battery (included).
- Slide down the battery compartment cover to open and take out the battery.
- After the battery is replaced, put the battery compartment cover back in place.

Safety & Care

- Gently wipe the LCD screen with a soft cloth to clean.
- Do not press stylus too hard against the LCD screen.
- Do not use sharp objects on the screen.
